

# The Beddington North TfL Major Scheme News Update



*Beddington Village – information overleaf*

Sutton Council has secured £1.86m of Transport for London (TfL) funding for the Beddington North Major Scheme. This is being matched by council funding of £1.7m, to provide a total budget of £3.56m.

The council has developed designs for the Major Scheme in partnership with TfL. These designs focus on delivering improvements to Beddington Lane and Hilliers Lane, making it better for pedestrians and cyclists, and providing more travel choices for local businesses and residents. The project will also significantly enhance the appearance of the area.

## Consultation Feedback

Comments showed strong support in principle for the proposals, especially on the issues relating to the weight limit of heavy goods vehicles (HGVs) through the village and the continuous cycle link and improvements to the public areas in Beddington Village. Following the consultation in July 2017, all comments were analysed, designs were then revised and submitted to TfL.

## Beddington Village

*Public realm improvements with new pedestrian crossings at Beddington Village with high quality materials highlighting the character of the Conservation Area and better management of heavy goods vehicles (HGVs) going through the village.*



## Beddington Farmlands crossing

*A segregated pedestrian and cycle lane along Beddington Lane with a signalised crossing will provide safer travel for residents and connect with the future routes through Beddington Farmlands.*



## Asda junction

*A new roundabout and a safe pedestrian and cycle crossing at Beddington Lane Asda junction.*



## Beddington Lane Tramlink stop

*Area outside Beddington Lane Tramlink Stop will be improved with better signage, way-finding and new seating facilities. This will also mark the start of a new pedestrian and cycle route which will run adjacent to the entire length of Beddington Lane.*

## Phase 1 Improvement Works

The first phase of the Beddington North TfL Major Scheme construction will commence from **22 January 2018 and will last for approximately 16 weeks**. The Council will be working in partnership with FM Conway Ltd contractors. This covers the area from A232 Croydon Road to Derry Road – Beddington Village and road resurfacing of Beddington Lane Tramlink to Coomber Way roundabout.
