The first bullet point of the key areas outlined in this consultation is:

Cleaner Transport

To this end we are making call for good cycling infrastructure to enable more people to make that modal shift away from cars towards active & public transport and see cycling as a big part of that for the number of journeys between 2-6km in length. This requires proper cycling routes on quiet roads or segregated paths in line with Liveable Neighbourhoods² and the Mayor's Transpost Strategy³
