

## Local Implementation Plan – Traffic schemes 2020/21

### 1: Brookfield Avenue / Wrythe Lane / West Street (to railway bridge) (Carshalton Central | *The Wrythe*)

Completion of scheme to improve crossing facilities and pedestrian environment. Measures to encourage more people to cycle. Public transport infrastructure improvements.  
(partly in St Helier local committee area)

### 2: Kings Lane / Fairview Road / Harrow Road and Cambridge Road / Wales Road area (Carshalton Central)

Completion of scheme to improve pedestrian routes within the area, and address through traffic and speed related concerns.

### 3: Beeches Avenue / Stanley Park Road – Phase 2 (Carshalton South and Clockhouse)

Completion of the introduction of speed reduction measures, improved crossing facilities and pedestrian environment. Measures to encourage more people to cycle. Public transport infrastructure improvements.

### 4: Westmead Road and Lower Road – Speed reduction measures (Carshalton Central | *Sutton Central*)

Investigation and feasibility study to consider extension of 20mph limit.  
(partly in Sutton local committee area)

*The Local Implementation Plan (LIP) – Traffic Schemes 2020/21 report (25 June 2019) notes “It is anticipated that £100,000 will still be available for the LTF to be split between the local committees in 2020/21. This local committee is expected to have an allocation of £10,892 and the schemes can be decided at a later date”. Although ‘Appendix A’ to the report does not include details of any new proposed LTF schemes at this time, the report does provides progress on one ongoing LTF scheme (see below).*

*Progress on schemes being delivered (25 June 2019):*

### 1: **Westmead Road** 20mph (Carshalton Central):

*To reduce speed and improve safety on this road. The scheme would involve investigation and consultation as well as preliminary design of an option(s) from Westmead Corner/Colston into the Sutton Central ward area. Total cost for above would be £8K. (Amount amended at Local Committee decision from initial £6K). (Decision date 7 May 2019; Anticipated completion date December 2019) (Allocated £8,000)*
