

Local Implementation Plan – Traffic schemes 2020/21

- 1: Brighton Road / Langley Park Road (South Sutton) area – second year of a two year scheme (Sutton South)**
Measures to encourage more people to walk, cycle and use public transport for local journeys such as speed reduction measures and improved crossing facilities.
- 2: Cheam Railway Station area – second year of a two year scheme (Cheam)**
Improved pedestrian and cycle routes to the station access in Station Way and Upper Mulgrave Road

The 'Local Implementation Plan (LIP) – Traffic Schemes 2020/21' report (13 June 2019) notes "It is anticipated that £100,000 will still be available for the LTF split between the local committees in 2020/21. This local committee is expected to have an allocation of £15,749 and the schemes can be decided at a later date". The 'Public Realm update table and budget position' report (13 June 2019) does not include details of any new proposed LTF schemes. However, the report does provide progress on four traffic/transport LTF schemes, see below.

Public Realm Update Table and Budget Report Local Transport Fund 2020/21

Progress on schemes being delivered (13 June 2019):

- 1: Dorset Road /(Brasted Close) Motorbike Restrictions signage (Belmont):**
Provide signage which will restrict motorbikes from entering the Brasted Close residential area through the existing road closure as this has caused noise disruption and safety concerns to the largely residential area. (Month / Year (DDN signed) May 2019; Anticipated completion date September 2019) (Allocated £2,000)
- 2: Northey Avenue Activated Sign (Cheam):**
Purchase and installation of a VAS which will indicate speed of travel for vehicles driving along Northey Avenue. (Month / Year (DDN signed) May 2019; Anticipated completion date September 2019) (Allocated £2,500)
- 3: Tudor Close entry treatment (Cheam):**
To install an entry treatment to alleviate the issues of cars speeding onto Tudor Close from Malden Road. (Month / Year (DDN signed) May 2019; Anticipated completion date September 2019) (Allocated £11,249)
- 4: Downs Road between Brighton Road and Cotswold Rd (Belmont):**
Previously scheme 1718.9 which was to add an entry treatment at the junction with Cotswold Road. Have now added measures for Downs Road area, to stop residents parked cars from being damaged; have added in removing some parking bays to create more passing places; and have added in supplying a new sign saying 'narrow footway'. Preferred option to be determined prior to consultation with residents. (Month / Year (DDN signed) 26 June 2018; Anticipated completion date September 2019) (Allocated £6,249)
